POSITION SUMMARY

Under the supervision and guidance of the Sports Director, the umpire's position is to officiate the game from beginning to end, enforcing the rules of the game, making judgement calls on plays, and handling disciplinary actions.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide game rule enforcement
- Assist in teaching specific sports skills (if needed)
- Responsible for equipment
- Attend and support planned activities (games, clinics, training events, etc.)
- Report injuries, cancellations, etc. to Sports Director following games
- Responsible for conduct of the total site area: games and parents.
- Demonstrate and interpret YMCA philosophy to players, parents and coaches
- Meet with both coaches before each game to discuss any ground rules, problems, etc.
- Know and enforce YMCA rules of the sport
- Stop play when necessary and explain violations consistently and fairly
- Alert coaches when play is too rough, or player needs to be cooled off
- Administer First Aid and CPR when necessary, know Emergency protocol
- Communicate problems or concerns to Sports Director
- Communicate information from Director to parents, coaches and players
- Use positive public relations when dealing with concerns from parents and coaches
- Follows YMCA policies and procedures, including those related to medical and disciplinary situations, child abuse prevention emergencies.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum age of 17 years old
- Specific knowledge of game rules and sports activity
- Must clear a background/criminal history check
- Desire and ability to work with children of all ages
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Must have excellent leadership skills and strong verbal communications
- CPR, First Aid, AED certifications and Child Abuse Prevention training within 30 days of hire date
