Pool Policies: Please initial each line

_____ If a child CAN swim, they are allowed to use both pools. A child that "can swim" is based on their ability to pass our YMCA Lap Pool swim test. This swim test consists of swimming 25 yards, treading water for 30-60 seconds in the deep end of the pool, and swimming back 25 yards without stopping or using the wall for assistance.

_____ If a child CANNOT swim, then a parent or guardian (18+), must always stay within arm's reach in the Activity Pool only.

_____ 1:3 adult/child ratio for non-swimming children.

_____ Parental supervision is mandatory in pool and locker rooms.

_____ Following all pool policies including no shoes on deck, no plastic flotation devices, hair longer than shoulder length needs to be put up into ponytail or swim cap.

_____ Children under 16 are not allowed in the men's or women's locker rooms at any time. Parents bring children through the boys or girls' bathrooms corresponding with the parents' gender.

_____ Depending on party time, there may be other swimmers present.

_____ Pool party timeslots begin after 11:00 am on weekends.

Waiver and Release: Please Initial each line:

_____ I hereby release, discharge and/or otherwise indemnify the YMCA, its affiliated organization and sponsors, their employees and association personnel, including the owners of facilities utilized, against any claim by or on behalf of any child participating in a YMCA birthday party.

_____ I acknowledge and understand that there are risks associated with participation in YMCA birthday party activities and the use of the pools, gym equipment, rock wall, and LU equipment. Some injuries that could occur but not limited to concussions, fractures, scrapes, cuts, bumps, paralysis or death. Which is why children should be always supervised by a parent or guardian (18+)

_____ I, for myself and the participant(s) named, willingly assume the risks associated with participation and accept that there are also risks that may arise due to OTHER PARTICIPANTS, which I also willingly assume.

_____ I agree that the participant(s) is named, and I shall comply with all stated and customary terms, posted safety signs, rules, and verbal instructions as conditions for participation in any party at the Geneva Lakes Family YMCA.

_____ I am legally competent to understand and complete this agreement. I hereby execute this agreement without coercion.

_____ I hereby give consent for emergency medical care prescribed by a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Dentistry. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb or well-being of the above-named participant.
